Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to Rajiv Lochan Ayurved Medical College, Village & Post-Chandkhuri Gunderdehi Road, Distt. Durg- 491221, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID AYU0018) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the scade of session 2024-25 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1770 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the Helional Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 1 day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act. 2020, Medican standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of MCISM Act. 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and clie intrastructure facilities at your college namely Rajiv Lochan Ayurved Medical College, Village & Pus-Chandkhuri Gunderdehi Road, Distt. Durg- 491221, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID AYU0018), inspection your College was conducted on 01.02.2024 & 02.02.2024 and revisited on 12.02.2024 & 13.02.2024 Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Bobb NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 20 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforces regulations parady, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for unsergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The National Commission for India System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2020, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- 3. Theresitis, the assessment report was placed in the 93rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 13.06.2024. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your coilege is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:
 - 1. Teaching staff (For UG):-
 - Avoilability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) is desirable videous = 10 vicus = 20 vicus

- However, as per regulation 3(3) (a) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for conditional permission for the academic year 2024-25. Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
 - Therefore, Conditional Permission is granted to Rajiv Lochan Ayurved Medical College, Village & Post- Chandkhuri Gunderdehi Road, Distt. Durg- 491221, Chhattisgarh (Inst. ID AYU0018) with 60 soats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -
 - 1. The coilege shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit quiy notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - If it is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all fr quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government A.V. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seets in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide refine SUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed ac per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
 - 6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 - 7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, stendards and benchmarks such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essen standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (4) as NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
 - Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Madicine, NCISM.
